- **2.** A sample of academic or other written work such as a chapter from your honours thesis or a term paper from an upper level undergraduate seminar. (10-25 pages in length)
- 3. A current CV/Resume.
- **4.** Transcripts: We will accept uploaded unofficial transcripts for evaluation purposes. Applicants must upload a grading scale with their unofficial transcripts. Successful applicants will be required to submit official final transcripts.
- **5.** Three (3) recommendation forms.
- 6. Official Proof of English Language Proficiency (if required).

Graduate Funding: All full-time graduate students who apply by February 1 are considered for FGSR graduate funding and those who are successful are officially notified by the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research (FGSR).
